Welcome to Santa Fe Indian School, High School Academics and Student Living programs! We are eager to meet and welcome your child to high school.

The Santa Fe Indian School's Freshmen Learning Community is an initiative that focuses on providing all students with a successful transition to high school. With this priority, our 9<sup>th</sup> grade team has designed a fun and exciting freshmen summer orientation called Fresh Start. The three-day orientation for all 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will:

- Introduce students to the academic faculty, staff, and high school academic expectations;
- Conduct team building activities to foster friendship and support among the students in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade.

Dorm check in will be Thursday, July 27, 2023 between 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM. Day students will need to be on campus by 8:00 AM and picked up by 4:00 PM. All students must be picked up Saturday July, 29 between 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM.

## What to bring:
