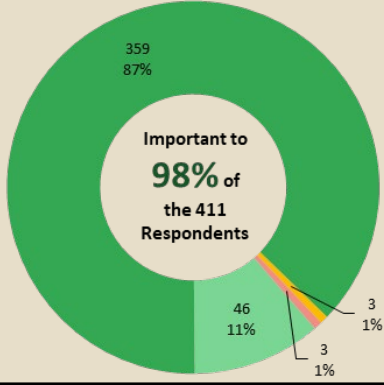


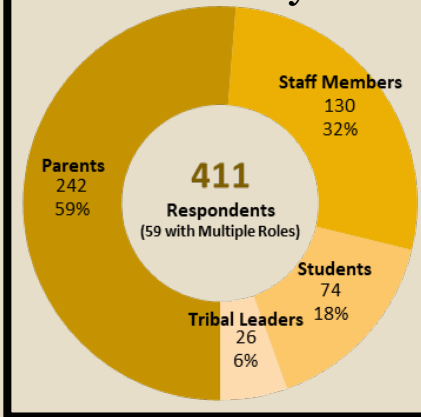


SFIS Spring 2021 Superintendent Search Survey Results

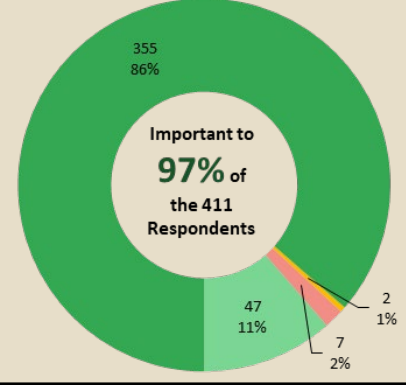
How important is it that the new superintendent have knowledge of Pueblo culture and the student population to be served?



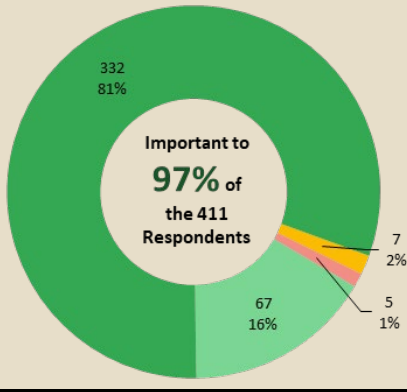
Who responded to the survey?



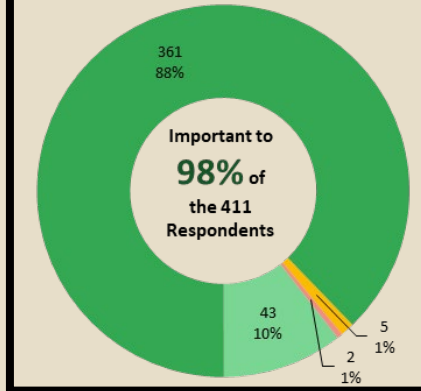
How important is it that the new superintendent have experience working with and educating Native American students?



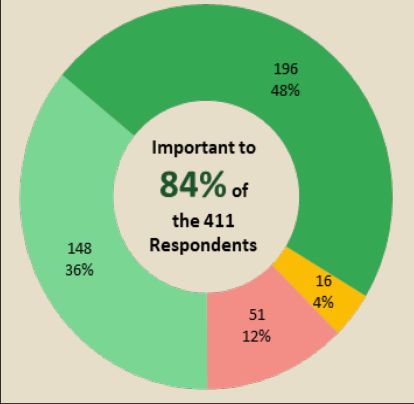
How important is it for the new superintendent to understand trust land and tribal sovereignty?
