All students will be required to stay at the Middle School Dorm

What to bring:

- Linen: twin sheets, pillowcase and pillow, bedspread and/or blanket.
- Toiletries: toothpaste, toothbrush, brush or comb, shampoo, deodorant, lotion, and body wash. Optional: foot powder, feminine hygiene products, shaving supplies, facial tissue, and hand soap.
- Towels: bath, hand, and washcloths.
- Casual clothing, gym shoes, gym clothes, shower shoes (optional), and underclothing.
- Personal: curling iron, blow dryer.
- Combination or padlock for closets.
- Swimsuit and towel for field trip.

Students are expected to dress appropriately and should avoid bringing any clothes that are revealing or would be considered inappropriate for a learning environment.

The Middle School Team would also like to emphasize that JumpStart is a “Cell Phone-Free” event. Students will be asked to leave their mobile devices in their dorm rooms during most of the agenda and events. Students will be given time to use their phones in the evening.
