Rail Safety: Look, Listen, Live!

..... Tips for train safety



Look Twice

Look both ways and listen before crossing the tracks. Expect a train at any time and from either direction.

Heads Up

Avoid dangerous distractions such as texting, loud music or headphones that would prevent you from hearing an approaching train.



Stand Back

Always stay behind the yellow lines at train stations. Enter or exit a station platform at designated areas.



Stay Off the Tracks

Train tracks, bridges and yards are private property. Never walk, bike, skateboard or run on or along the tracks; it's illegal and dangerous. Cross only at designated rail crossings.



Hold Hands

Hold hands with smaller children while at stations and crossings.



Just Wait

Don't ever try to "beat" a train. An approaching train is closer and moves faster than you think. Don't assume the operator sees you and do not step in front of a train for any reason.



See Something, Say Something!

Report suspicious packages, activities, and/or persons by calling 911, or by pushing the red emergency call button on station kiosks.



We trust that our students are respectful of themselves and others as they ride the Friday afternoon RailRunner home. There have been some concerns raised of inappropriate and disrespectful behaviors on board.

Some of the issues include: horseplay, disruptive behavior, talking too loudly, and continually walking between cars.

So we ask that our students to:

- keep their IDs on lanyards in full view
- be courteous and respectful,
