<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• PMG will be on site administering Accula Rapid PCR tests on campus for return from spring break</li> <li>• These tests take 30 minutes to process, and testing can get backed up causing wait times of up to <b>MULTIPLE HOURS</b></li> <li>• Please arrive for testing as early as possible</li> <li>• Students cannot check into dorms without a wristband (after verifying a negative test result at test results station)</li> <li>• Dorms open early at <b>1 PM</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be dropped off at Pueblo Pavilion</li> <li>• Students will remain in Pueblo Pavilion until negative results are processed</li> <li>• Students will receive a wristband with negative results and will be sent to class</li> <li>• If students tested on Sunday and did not stay to receive wristband, they will have to visit results table in Pueblo Pavilion to receive wristband before continuing elsewhere on campus</li> </ul>
<b>What if my student shows up after testing hours on Sunday?</b>	<b>What if my student doesn't return until after the 24<sup>th</sup> or 25<sup>th</sup>?</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your student <b>WILL NOT</b> be allowed to test to check into the dorms after testing hours</li> <li>• ^ if your student HAS been tested and you are waiting on results you WILL be able to check in to dorms once results are received</li> <li>• Testing hours have been extended to all day Sunday, for this reason there is a hard stop after testing hours have ended</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All SFIS members will be tested upon first return from spring break</li> <li>• If first return arrival falls on a Friday, students will be directed to test at Pod D by PMG</li> <li>• If first return arrival falls any other day, students will be directed to test at the health center by SFIS health staff</li> <li>• Parents/Guardians will have to remain with their students until negative results are received</li> </ul>
